

Earl's Diary - Monday - July 13, 2009

I left Galt at 6:15 this morning (only 15 minutes later than I had planned. That's good for me!!)

My travel route included I-5 to Williams; across Highway 20 through Clear Lake; Highway 101 to Redcrest. I was very thankful for rest stops on 101 where I was able to eat lunch and have a short nap before continuing on.

I arrived at Ancient Redwoods RV park at 2:00. This is a brand new RV park set among the old redwoods on the Avenue of the Giants Highway. The park is so new they haven't finished with the improvements including showers and a swimming pool yet. It is however very clean and the restrooms are spotless. When I arrived there was only 1 other RV in the whole place. Tonight others have arrived and now there are 7 of us. It's nice and quiet here - and they have WiFi.
