The thermometer inside registered 225 degrees. Just enough to bake the bread without burning it!



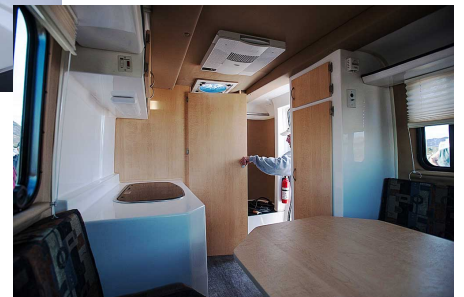
I found some other dutch oven cooking going on.
